

Maintain your Certification

Maintain your certification in the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) and in the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada by peer reviewing for CIHR.

CFPC requires members to obtain at least 25 credits per year and 250 credits per 5-year cycle.

Peer Review falls under the **Activity Category** of Self-Learning, and is a non-certified activity.

Committee participation counts towards one non-certified credit per hour of participation.

Earn Credits

Peer Review activity is eligible for credits in the Royal College Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Program under MOC Section 3:

Feedback and Improvement/Feedback delivered

Unaccredited activities with financial or in-kind support by commercial interests are not eligible for MOC credits.
